

## Current information for our guests (COVID-19)

Currently the following provisions apply in the Rheingau-Taunus district:

Whether extended measures apply in the Rheingau-Taunus district depends on the seven-day incidence (from incidence above 35) of the district. With the date of 05 of September 2021 the incidence is above 100.

### PRIVATE MEETINGS

10-person contact limit for non-vaccinated or non-recovered persons. Event rules apply for 25 persons or more.

### CONTACT TRACING

The Rheingau-Taunus-Kreis relies on the free application "luca" for contact tracking. It is best to download and set up the application with your contact details before your visit to avoid queues. Of course, you can still leave contact details in analogue form.

### OVERNIGHT STAYS

are allowed under certain conditions. For stays for tourist purposes, negative proof, such as negative PCR or Antigen Rapid Test, Vaccination certificate or Recovery certificate must be presented on arrival;

For incidence over 35, negative proof is required twice a week for longer stays.

### GASTRONOMY

Indoor and outdoor gastronomy are open. Masks are compulsory until you reach your seats. A contact sheet is required. If the incidence exceeds 100, admission to indoor and outdoor seating is only possible for guests with negative proof.

### MASK DUTY

The wearing of a medical mask (surgical masks or virus-filtering masks of the standards FFP2, KN95 or N95) is mandatory:

public areas of wholesale and retail trade including shop streets, weekly markets, in shops of the food trade as well as post offices, banks, petrol stations, laundries and similar establishments, for the use of local public transport

Self-made fabric masks are no longer permitted.

### SIGHTS

The opening of zoos, botanical gardens and museums in the open air will continue to be permitted, subject to the observance of a distance and hygiene concept in compliance with the recommendations of the Robert Koch Institute on hygiene, the control of access and the avoidance of queues.

If the incidence is above 35, admission to the interior of cultural and recreational facilities and to the interior of sports facilities is only permitted with negative proof, vaccination certificate or recovery certificate.
